WEB & PRESS RELEASE: Abergele Firework Display Sat 29th Oct 2016

Abergele Round Table have been granted a permit to stage the 2016 firework display at **Pensarn Beach** and **foreshore** on **Saturday 29th October 2016**.

This year the unique toddler's display and the main display **are on Saturday night of October 29th**. The beach is proving an ideal venue due to the existence of the hard-standing promenade and car park areas, making it a perfect viewing area, with a large area separate area for Knightly's Funfair to offer amusements, rides and refreshments. The beach and promenade provide enough room for 10,000 spectators and a large exclusion area from which to safely launch the fireworks away from the A55, railway, residential areas and spectators.

On **Saturday 29th October**, Knightly's Funfair will be open from **5.00pm onwards**. Abergele Round Table will put on a small fireworks display for local toddlers at **6:30pm (please arrive by 6pm)** with an emphasis on a safe, colourful event - without too much noise. The display will take place by the sea-wall access ramp at the Sea Road end of the promenade by the Funfair. We also plan to have a large bonfire **at 7:00pm weather permitting**.

The main firework display will be on **Saturday 29th October at 7:45pm** and will comprise of:

- The full Funfair, novelty stalls, food, teas, coffees and other amusements.
- The 2016 pyrotechnic display (starting at 7.45pm), by the Wizzard Fireworks Company from Sussex, it promises to be a wonderful spectacle for the whole family and the largest display in North Wales!

The organisers expect a very large turnout to the event (in excess of 6000!), making it one of the best attended displays in North Wales. Spectators **for the main event are advised to arrive early** (recommended time **6.30pm onwards**) as there will be **no parking on the promenade or beach whatsoever** during Saturday evening as the area will be subject to a Police Road Closure Order. **The road will be closed to all vehicles from 5:00pm onwards with no exceptions**, making the area safer for pedestrians. For disabled parking, please contact the organisers at least 24 hours before the event on 07774 834166 or 01745 822922 – **latest disabled access is 6.30pm**. All vehicle exits will be **prohibited until 8:30pm by barriers**.

The Round Table wishes to thank over 20 local businesses for their kind donations and the spectators for their contributions (on entry to the display), ensuring the continued success of this major community event. We would also like to thank Conwy County Council, Abergele Town Council, the local police, St John's Ambulance and all our volunteers for their assistance. Special mention to our many traditional sponsors, especially Threeways and WorldSpan.

Entry **to both of the displays** is £2.50 per adult, £1 per child (over 5 years), or £7 per family of (2 adults + 2 children). All profits from the event will be returned to the local community and local charities via Abergele Round Table charity funds.
