Dear Councillor Wood.

The proposed tourism signing for Abergele is out of our hands for the time being.

The process I am told that for the provision of tourism signing from the A55 Trunk road, where the Welsh Government are the Highway Authority is as follows;

- The applicant must apply to the Welsh Government for the consideration of tourism signing, by filling the appropriate form, which I believe was done in October 2018.
- If the Welsh Government agree to the provision of signing they will instruct The North and Mid Wales Trunk Road Agency commission someone to draw up a signing scheme, which is likely to be CCBC as we have already had involvement.
- The completed signing scheme will be sent back to NWTRA to approve and safety audit the signing scheme.
- If NEWTRA are happy with the signing scheme the Welsh Government will be informed and we are likely to be asked to consult with the applicant and arrange the provision of the signs.

We are unable to take this matter forward until instructed to design a signing scheme, which we have virtually completed already. It is not for Chris Jones to chase up the Welsh Government for a decision.

I have responded to the matter of the parking review in my last email, which I will try to substantially progress before retiring.

* A review of the car parking signing will be undertaken as soon as we are able. *
