This summer we are adding sports and games to our play sessions and having a weekly theme to base our activities around.

As well as getting wet, muddy and messy with our free play; we will also be offering a range of arts and crafts, structured games and sports in every session, based around the following themes:

COMMONWEALTH – It's 2014 and the Commonwealth Games start in Glasgow on the 23rd July. Come along and try a variety of games based on some Commonwealth sports, as well as themed arts and crafts.

CIRCUS – Come and play with our circus skills kit, build circus tents, tightropes, dress as a clown, create a show, or play some games.

BEACH – Whether you live near the sea or in rural Conwy you can enjoy building sand castles, play volleyball, make some beach art, play with water and fly kites.
