The Minutes of the Parks, Street Scene & CCTV Sub-Committee held on 10th September were **RECEIVED** and **APPROVED**.

412/18 Matters arising:

- a) An update regarding grant funding for the Pentre Mawr toilets installation was **RECEIVED**. The Deputy Clerk reported that such a project is likely eligible for funding for a variety of sources. A grant application would need to be considerably detailed as to the design, cost, sustainability and benefit to the community over the long term. A report establishing the detail and costs is to be prepared.
- b) Information regarding the proposed siting of hanging basket columns in Bridge St. was **RECEIVED**. The proposed sites were reviewed and the column near the bus-stop was eliminated. Shopowners are to be contacted for their views.

413/18 An e-mail regarding the installation of traffic calming device on Dundonald Ave., deferred from the GPP, was **CONSIDERED**. Cllr McCoubrey attended a public meeting to discuss the issue of speed safety along Dundonald Avenue in light of two recent incidents. It was **RESOLVED** to invite the member of public who convened the public meeting and a road/speed safety expert to a future meeting Thanks were extended to Cllr McCoubrey for raising the matter.

In accordance with the Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings Act) 1960 and with Standing Order no.68, in view of the confidential nature of the business about to be transacted, it was advised in the public interest that the press and public be temporarily excluded and instructed to withdraw (Agenda item 8(a) & (b))

- a) Quotes for the supply, installation, watering and removal of the hanging baskets in Market Street 2019/20 were **RECEIVED**. Based on the previous

year's display in the town, it was **RECOMMENDED** that Council **APPROVE** for 2019/20 Estimates the quote of £425 provided by CCBC for the supply of the hanging baskets contents, and Bebbington & Wilson for the installation and removal of the baskets at £600 under the Hanging Basket budget heading. A quote for watering the baskets is still pending from CCBC but based on 2018/19 figures is expected to be in the region of £1000.

- b) No quotes for the maintenance of the town planters to date had been received. Members discussed the scope of the contract and proposed that the brief should be expanded to include the concrete planters and the rail planters in Pensarn.
