Hi Mandy,

Hope you're well.

Just a quick email to say I have spoken to Meirion at Menter Iaith following Cllr Woods question/enquiry re the Welsh language project submission. The project submission quotes the cost as £11,053.60 but also contains the following text....

'As we do not receive grants to work full time from our Core Grant, we would contribute quite a bit in preparation, but receiving money for the plan's administration would allow us to raise our ability to work intensively in the area for one year. We would be able to contribute to half of the costs in our usual work, therefore we would offer to do the work for £5,526.80. This would leave the money set aside in the fund to hold specific events that the community and Menter Iaith Conwy would identify as gaps in the present local provision. Then, it would be us commissioning and arranging these events.'

Cllr Andrew asked whether this means the final costs to the Place Plan Committee would be £5,526.80 or £11,053.60. I was unsure of the answer as I read it to mean the remaining 50% would still be required to 'hold specific events that the community and Menter Iaith Conwy would identify as gaps in the present local provision' and that ultimately the full £11,053.60 would be required. When I spoke to Meirion he suggested the remaining funds would still be required towards the full programme and that an initial meeting would be useful to discuss further. You may prefer to invite Meirion to the next meeting to discuss the brief and the programme involved in more detail or alternatively meet with Meirion and report back at the next meeting before proceeding.

It could also give an opportunity to discuss the website translation issue at the same time.

Let me know what you think.
