Standing orders were suspended

The Chairman welcomed Mr Steve Teale, Facilities Manager from CCBC to the meeting who provided members with an overview of options with regard to toilet provision in Pentre Mawr Park. Mr Teale informed members that he is responsible for crematorium, allotments and toilet facilities and has been in the role for four years. Mr Teale agreed that there is a need for toilets in Pentre Mawr Park and under the Public Health Wales Act the public need to be able to access public conveniences. There is a push to be able to access these facilities. The old toilets in the park have unique problem as it is an old Victorian building and beyond satisfactory condition to be brought up to standard. The location in the park presents a risk of anti-social behaviour given previous experience in other similar locations. The cost will be to be balanced between the renovation over use of other facilities i.e. the Rugby Club services. Other areas of the park are also not feasible and located close to the Rugby Club would act as a deterrent to anti-social behaviour.

Mr Teale will forward some models to the Clerk for members' observations. There is a Welsh Government documents that enforces County Councils to evaluate the need for toilets but does not state where the funds are required to be accessed from.

A question was raised with regard to comparison of population and toilets provision compared with other Towns in County and considered that Abergele did not have as many public toilets as other areas.

A member who is also the Chairman of the Rugby Club informed Mr Teale that the WREN funding prohibited public use of the toilets in the club but would be happy to work with the officer to view a solution to the current problem.

## Cllr Bond arrived at this juncture

An additional building to the side or the rear of the Rugby Club was proposed.

The Chairman thanked Mr Teale for his attendance
