394/19 **Minutes**

-It was **RESOLVED** to receive, **APPROVE** and sign the Minutes of the Parks, Street Scene & CCTV Sub-Committee held on 9<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

395/19 **Matters Arising**

- a) The officer from CCBC was unable to attend the meeting for an update on the costs associated with the refurbishment of the toilet block in Pentre Mawr Park and a broader scheme including Water Street and Pensarn.
- b) The Officer from CCBC for Traffic to discuss the acquisition by ATC of the carparks, was also not in attendance

*Standing Orders were suspended*

PCSO Jones was welcomed to the meeting. PCSO Jones expressed his interest in the Council's current efforts to install traffic calming measures. He is regularly approached by members of the public regarding road safety since a fatal road accident in the town almost two years ago. PCSO Jones suggested that a contribution towards funding for speed radar signs may be available may be available from NWP as part of their community engagement.

Efforts by staff and a Member of the committee to obtain a meaningful response regarding the installation of speed signs in Abergele from CCBC have failed.

*Standing Orders were reinstated*

In accordance with the Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings Act) 1960 and with Standing Order no.68, it was **RESOLVED** that, in view of the confidential nature of the business about to be transacted, it was advisable in the public interest that the press and public be temporarily excluded and they were instructed to withdraw.

396/19 Information regarding costs associated with speed radar signs was **RECEIVED**. Members discussed traffic calming measures at length and **RECOMMENDED** the following:

- That ATC should commit to purchasing 5 bi-lingual radar speed signs at an approx. cost of £12k to be located at each entry point to the town.
- To purchase one sign immediately at £2395 and phase the remainder in as funding becomes available.
- That part funding should be sought from S106 monies and other sources.
- The suggested locations:
  - Llanfair Road, Abergele
  - Marine Road, Pensarn
  - Dundonald Avenue, Abergele
  - Rhuddlan Road, Abergele
  - Llanddulas, Road Abergele

It was **RESOLVED** to obtain advice from CCBC as to the most advantageous position for the signs.

It was further **RESOLVED** to write to CCBC for clarity on the stipulations for allocating S106 funds generated by the Annwyl development on Llanfair Road.

397/19 An update from CCBC regarding Dundonald Avenue Streetlighting was **RECEIVED**. Most of the lighting problems have been resolved but it is still a work in progress and dependent on Scottish Power. It was **RESOLVED** to request that CCBC obtains a connection date for the remaining streetlamp columns. One lamp is still shrouded in foliage and is to be reported.

398/19 An update from CCBC regarding carpark repairs was **RECEIVED**. A substantial amount of remedial work has now been completed but there are still some issues with Pensarn carpark outstanding.

399/19 An e-mail from members of the public complimenting the work of the footpath maintenance contractor was **NOTED**.
