PARCIO YNG NGHANOL Y DREF

Mae'r pwnc parcio ar linellau melyn dwbl ac ar balmentydd yng nghanol y dref ar Stryd y Farchnad a Stryd y Bont wedi dod i'r amlwg yng nghyfarfod diweddar y Pwyllgor Cyswllt Heddlu.

Dylid osgoi gwneud hyn ar unrhyw adeg, a bydd yr Heddlu'n cadw golwg manwl ar y sefyllfa'n ystod y misoedd nesaf.

AMDDIFFYNFYDD LLIFOGYDD

Mae cynllun amddiffyn rhag llifogydd newydd Abergele i warchod 223 o gartrefi a busnesau bellach wedi ei gwblhau. Fe agorwyd y cynllun yn swyddogol gan y Gweinidog Amgylchedd, John Griffiths AC, ar Fedi 11eg.

Fe adeiladwyd prosiect Abergele mewn dau gam. Y cam cyntaf oedd gosod ceuffos osgoi o dan Ffordd y Morfa i ganiatau i fwy o ddŵr i lifo. Yr ail gam oedd adeiladu waliau llifogydd ar hyd yr afon rhwng Parc Gele a'r geuffos osgoi newydd, tynnu ymaith gored uwchlaw Stryd-y-Bont, ac yn ei le gosod ramp garreg i ganiatau i bysgod symud i fyny'r afon, ac fe osodwyd 100 metr o roliau rhisgl coconyt ar hyd glan yr afon. Wedi cwblhau'r cynllun fe ddarparodd Asiantaeth yr Amgylchedd Berllan Gymunedol ym Mharc Gele.

HAFOD Y PARC

Mae'r gwaith wedi cychwyn o ail-ddatblygu safle'r hen Awel-y-Môr ac fe gynhaliwyd seremoni 'cychwyn ar safle' ar Fedi 21ain.

Disgwylir y bydd y datblygiad newydd hwn, a fydd yn cynnwys 49 fflat byw annibynnol i bobl 60 oed a throsodd gydag anghenion cefnogaeth yn barod erbyn Tachwedd 2013.

TOWN COUNCIL NEWS (cont'd)

PARKING IN THE TOWN CENTRE

The matter of parking on double yellow lines and on the pavements in the centre of town on Market and Bridge Street has been highlighted at the recent Police Liaison Committee.

This practice should be avoided at all times and the Police will be monitoring the situation carefully over the next few months.

FLOOD DEFENCE

Abergele's new flood defence alleviation scheme to protect 223 homes and businesses in the town has finally been completed. The Environment Minister, John Griffiths, AM officially opened the Scheme on the 11th September.

The Abergele project was built in two phases. The first phase was an installation of a bypass culvert underneath Ffordd y Morfa to provide additional flow capacity. The second phase included the construction of flood walls along the river between Gele Parc and the new bypass culvert, the removal of a weir upstream of Bridge St which was replaced by a rock ramp to allow fish to migrate upstream and a 100metres of coir rolls have been installed along the river bank. On completion of the Scheme the Environment Agency provided a Community Orchard in Gele Park.

HAFOD Y PARC

Work has started on redeveloping the old Awel y Môr site and an official 'start on site' Ceremony was held on the 21st September.

The new development, offering 49 apartments providing Independent Living for people aged 60 and over who have an assessed support need, is due for completion in November 2013.

Mae'r adeilad o'r bedwaredd ganrif ar bymtheg sydd wedi ei restru'n Radd 1 yn brosiect blaenoriaeth Datblygiadau'r Castell sydd newydd ei ffurfio, a'r bwriad yw iddo fod yn westy gwledig 5 seren gyda 75 ystafell wely, sba, pwll nofio, caffi, a chyfleusterau gwledda.

Yn gynwysedig yn y cynlluniau mae 8 ystafell wely benty, dwy adain newydd yn yr ardd gaeëdig ddwyreiniol, a thrydedd adain dri llawr yn cynnwys ceginau, a chyfleusterau gwledda a chynadledda.

Fe osodir to gwyrdr uwchben yr iard fewnol i lunio bar a chaffi, a hefyd fe ddarperir maes parcio gyda 240 lle ar gyfer gwesteion.

GWRYCH CASTLE

Gwrych castle is set to be converted into a luxury hotel after permission was granted by County Planning Committee on the 21st of November 2012.

The Grade I listed 19th century building is the flagship project of the newly formed Castell Developments and is planned as a five-star country hotel complete with 75 bedrooms, a spa, swimming pool, bar, cafe and banqueting facilities.

Included in the plans are eight penthouse bedrooms, two new wings in the eastern walled garden and a third three storey wing containing kitchens, banqueting and conference facilities.

A glazed roof will be constructed over the internal courtyard to form a bar and cafe whilst 240 car parking spaces will also be provided for guests.

ABERGELE AUTUMN CLUB

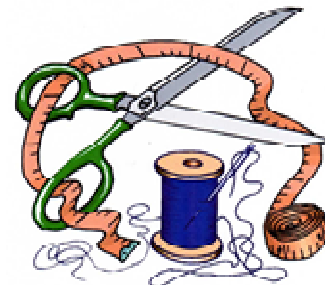
The Club is for over 50's, both male and female. We meet at 10.00am every Tuesday in Abergele Community Centre.

FRIENDS OF ABERGELE PARKLANDS

Thanks to WREN, a parkland is to be transformed into a £51,000 wildlife haven. Its centrepiece will be a large lake viewing platform providing visitors will excellent views of Pentre Mawr Park at Abergele. Designs will hopefully include a glass panel, in order to view wild bird nesting islands.

Cllr Andrew Woods welcomed the fantastic news "We've dreamed of such a project that can open up the parkland, this really is a dream come true", he said.

Sections of the viewing platform will give people the opportunity to walk through the tall reeds and access a close-up view of the habitat and its associated wildlife. It's inner edges will also be left clear, save for a safety rim which will enable groups to carry out pond dipping within the shallow waters in the centre of the platform.

Two islands will be created within the lake to provide a haven for nesting birds and other wildlife - these will be floating islands to take account of any fluctuations of water depth

Friends of Abergele Parklands are now working with WREN and Conwy County Council to finalise the grant arrangements and draw up a timescale for work to be carried out. WREN is not for profit business that awards grants to community projects.
