Pentre Mawr Park Viewing Platform

In late February, contractors arrived on site to de-silt and remove the excess reeds from the west bank of the large 'out-fall' pond (next to Sea Road).

Final design plans were agreed in March and have been approved by Conwy Council's engineering offices. The 8m x 4m hard-wood viewing platform will hopefully have been installed in late March/early April along with two new specially designed (by the Friends Group) circular (8m diameter) and oblong (8m x 2m) bird nesting islands that will provide sanctuary and security for nesting birds.

The Friends of Abergele Parklands wish to thank Abergele Town Council Conwy County Council designers, for the necessary resources to prepare the site and reed manage the area, and special thanks to the WREN Group whose generous funding and help has made this natural, educational and aesthetically pleasing project possible.

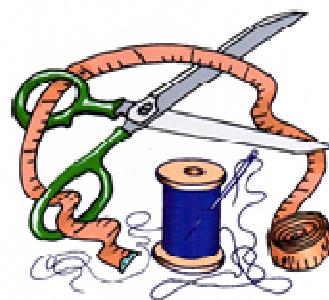
